### School Duties

Schools are expected to provide a person to help patrol the courts. This person will need to report to the downstairs Office at 3.45pm to collect their official jacket which must be returned at the end of the evening before leaving. This duty may be shared amongst adult personnel from the school.

Duty volunteers are asked to patrol the building, outside courts and the Arena making sure that children are playing in safe areas, not climbing the goal posts, fences, the building and checking children are supervised inside the building. Checks of the toilets and advising teams of the correct warm-up area is permissible. If your people become aware of problems courtside they are asked to report such incidents to the Office for the staff to address. **There is no riding bikes, scooters or skateboards. Dogs are also not permitted courtside (except for guide dogs). Umbrella points must not be poked into the surface. Stiletto heels are also banned and chewing gum prohibited. There is a No Smoking policy which includes the car park. Coffee is allowed courtside but we ask for lids to be on cups. FOOD COURTSIDE IS TO BE DISCOURAGED AND THERE IS NO FOOD OR DRINK IN THE ARENA (except for water bottles).** Please ask spectators not to stand behind the goal lines and to keep this area clear of any bags and other equipment.

In the case of an emergency, eg fire, duty members are also asked to help muster players and spectators towards Court 5 and 21 to evacuate to the cricket field.

Schools have been rostered so there are a number of teams on duty each night – roughly 3-4 - duties to be shared amongst the schools (some schools only have 1 team) throughout the night.
